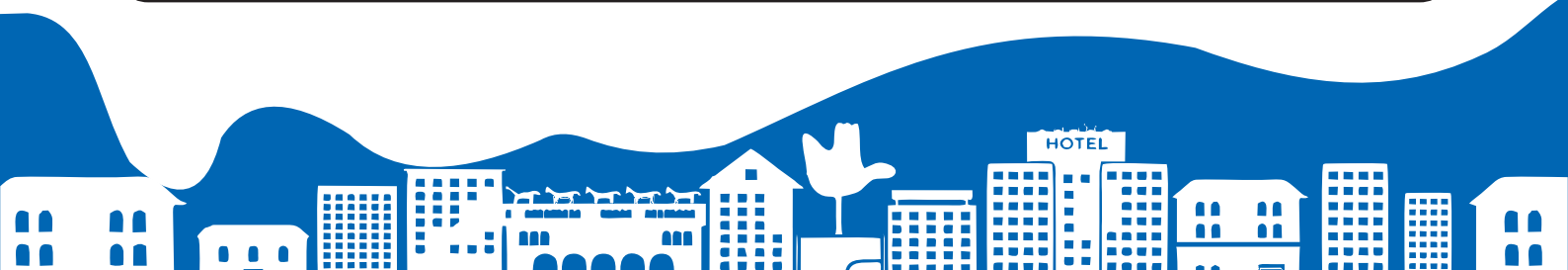

## WORKSHOP

## **Abstract Submission Guidelines**

### **Please read the instructions carefully prior to submitting your abstract**

- Abstracts are being invited for Oral Paper/ePosters (Scientific Exhibit / Educational Exhibit) presentations.
- Abstracts must be submitted online only through the website, abstracts submitted via email/fax or any other means will not be accepted.
- All abstracts must be submitted in English language only.
- Registration is mandatory for any kind of participation during the conference.
- Oral Papers /Scientific Exhibit ePosters must be written in 250 words and Educational Exhibit Posters must be written in 400 words.
- The title of the abstract must be concise, avoid using abbreviations.
- Oral Papers/Scientific Exhibit posters should have the following headings: Aim/purpose, methods, results and conclusions. Educational Exhibit E-Posters should include the following headings : Background, Learning Objectives, Imaging findings/Procedure details, Take home message.
- Do not include graphs/tables/images/references in the abstract. Do not mention the name of the institute or any author names in the abstract body.
- The abstract submission is open till 13th Oct 2023 midnight. Late submissions will NOT be accepted.
- Categories: Gastrointestinal, Hepatobiliary, Interventions, Pancreas, Pelvis - Female, Pelvis - Male, Physics and instrumentation, Urinary tract, Miscellaneous.
- In submitting the abstracts, the authors also grant the organising committee, the right to publish the abstract in electronic form.
- The submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the scientific committee. The review process is confidential, and the committee's decision is final.

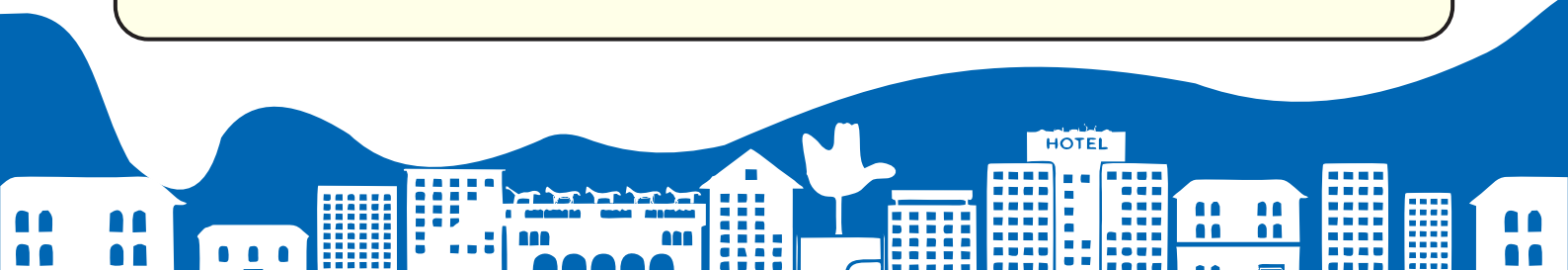

**GUIDELINES FOR ORAL  
PAPER PRESENTATION:**

- ⑩ Oral paper presentations will be power point presentations of 6 minutes duration with 2 minutes for questions and discussion. You are requested to kindly adhere to the timings.
- ⑩ Please ensure that patient confidentiality is protected. No patient's names, hospital numbers or any other identifying information can appear in the presentation.
- ⑩ Presentation can be structured in the same format as the abstract (Title, Aims and Objectives, Material and Methods, Results, Conclusion, Clinical relevance / take home message).
- ⑩ First slide shall consist of Title, Full name of presenter, designation, Co-authors - names and affiliations.
- ⑩ Total size of the presentation should not exceed 5 MB and 8-10 slides.
- ⑩ Animation/ movies/ sounds will not be supported; please submit in a static required template format only.
- ⑩ Paper will be judged on content, clinical relevance, clarity of presentation, time management and quality of slides.

- ⑩ Three prizes will be awarded for best oral papers.

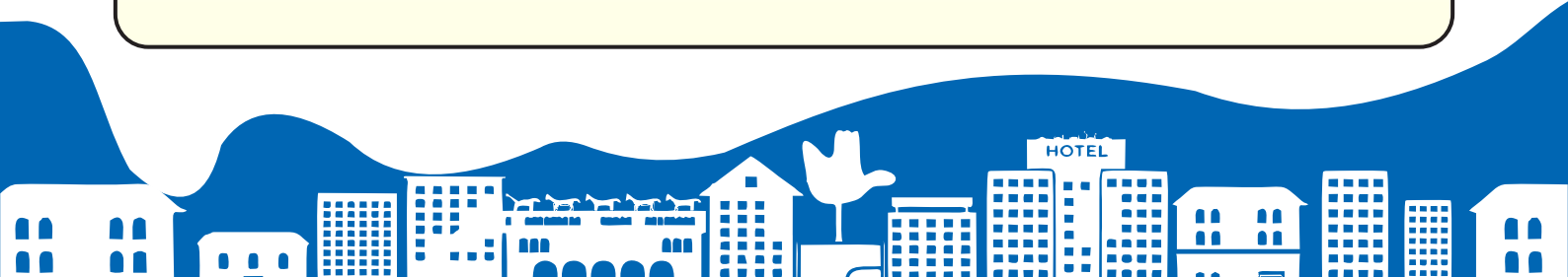

**GUIDELINES FOR E-POSTER  
PRESENTATION:**

- ⑩ The E-poster should be submitted as a power point presentation.
- ⑩ Total size of the presentation should not exceed 5 MB and 8-10 slides. The viewer should be able to read the poster in 5 minutes. Data presented should be clear and concise, all images should have legends.
- ⑩ Slides should be in landscape format in 16:9 ratio.
- ⑩ First slide shall consist of Title, Full name of presenter, designation, Co-authors - names and affiliations.
- ⑩ Animation/movies/sounds will not be supported; please submit in a static required template format only.
- ⑩ Please ensure that patient confidentiality is protected. No patient's names, hospital numbers or any other identifying information can appear in the presentation.
- ⑩ For Scientific exhibits: PowerPoint presentation comprising of 8-10 slides can be structured in the same format as the abstract (Title, Aims and Objectives, Material and Methods, Results, Conclusion, Clinical relevance / Take home message).
- ⑩ For Educational exhibits: PowerPoint presentation comprising of 10 slides can be structured in the same format as the abstract (Title, Aims and Objective, Imaging findings /procedure details/case presentation, Discussion, Summary, Clinical relevance / Take home message).
- ⑩ References can be included on relevant slides or at the end of the presentation.
- ⑩ Poster will be judged on content, quality of slides, and clinical relevance.
- ⑩ Presenting author maybe required to be present during the Judging.
- ⑩ Prizes will be awarded in both categories of E posters.



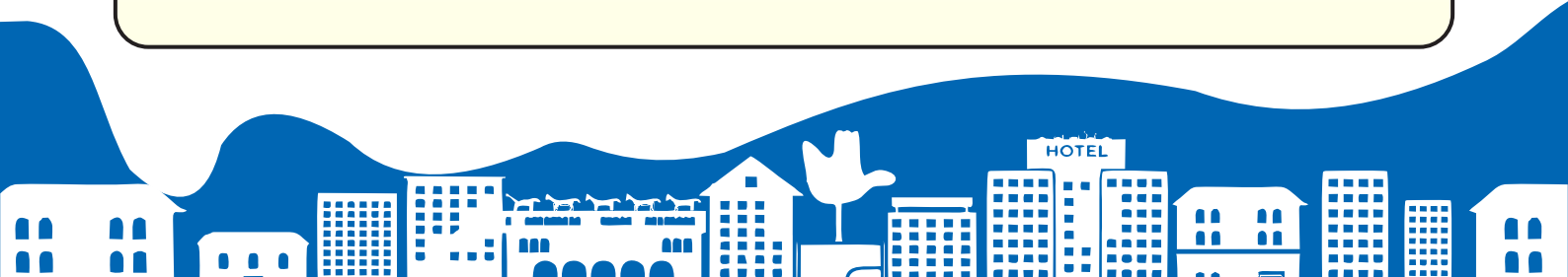

## **About Chandigarh**

Chandigarh, the City Beautiful, is a modern planned city located in North India. After Partition, the large North western province of Panjab was divided into East & West Panjab with the partition line leaving its erstwhile capital, Lahore in West Panjab. The city of Chandigarh was conceptualized to serve as the capital of East Panjab and was planned by a team of architects headed by the famous French architect, Le Corbusier with its foundation stone laid in 1953. After the reorganisation of states, Chandigarh was designated as a Union Territory and also the shared Capital of the states of Panjab & Haryana.

Picturesquely located in the foothills of the Shivaliks ranges, the city is internationally renowned for its architecture and urban design. The city abounds with tree-lined, wide boulevards, parks and green spaces as well as the tranquil Sukhna Lake. Some of its famous parks are the iconic Rock Garden designed by Nek Chand, the Zakir Rose Garden, Leisure Valley, Bougainville Garden, Shanti Kunj and the Garden of Fragrance.

### **Weather**

Mid-November is the end of autumn and onset of the winter season in Chandigarh. Expect pleasant sunny days with slightly chilly early mornings and late evenings. The temperature usually ranges between highs of 27- 29 and lows of 12-14 degrees centigrade. Delegates are advised to carry light woollens.

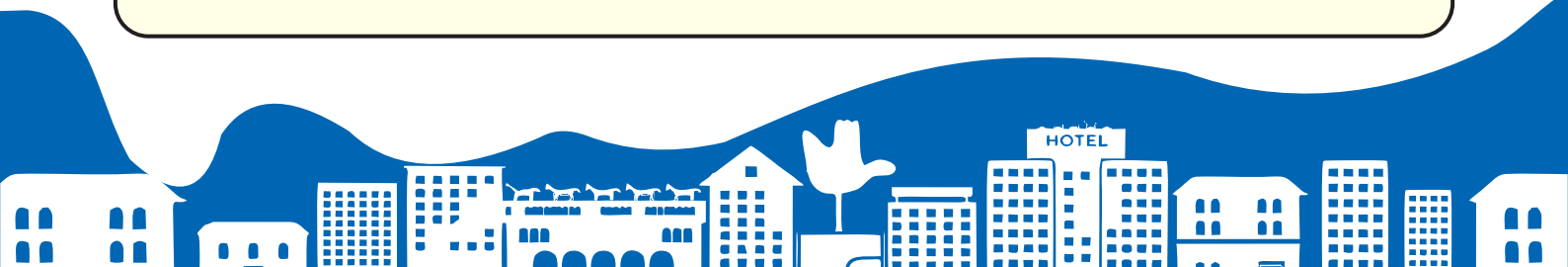
### **Getting to Chandigarh**
